



NOTIFICATION OF A SCHEME
Professional Standards Act 1994 (NSW)

The Association of Australian Certifiers Professional Standards Scheme

Notification is hereby given pursuant to section 8 of the *Professional Standards Act 1994* (NSW) (Act) of a Scheme prepared by The Association of Australia Certifiers (AAC) of Suite 1B, 668 Old Princes Highway, Sutherland NSW 2232.

The Scheme would:

- apply to Full Members of AAC and Student Members of AAC, who are practising Registered Certifiers and hold professional indemnity insurance as required by Division 1 of Part 3 of the *Building and Development Certifiers Act 2018* (NSW)
- apply to officers of bodies corporate, employees of a person, or partners in a partnership arrangement to whom the Scheme applies, unless the officer, employee or partner is entitled to be a member of AAC but is not a member
- limit the occupational liability of a person to whom the Scheme applies to \$1,000,000 or \$2,000,000, depending on the floor area and number of storeys of the building to which the occupational liability relates
- provide that a member of AAC to whom the Scheme applies may apply for an exemption from the scheme
- provide that a member of AAC to whom the Scheme applies may apply for a higher limit of liability, up to \$10,000,000
- require that members of the AAC to whom the Scheme applies have insurance for occupational liability of an amount not less than the amount of their limited liability, and
- require that members of AAC to whom the Scheme applies comply with relevant risk management strategies.

If approved by the Professional Standards Council of New South Wales, the Scheme would commence on 1 July 2026, after publication in the New South Wales Government Gazette. The Scheme is intended to remain in force from its date of commencement in New South Wales for five (5) years.

Before approving the scheme, the Professional Standards Council of New South Wales hereby invites comments and submissions to be made in writing and received by the Acting Chief Executive Officer, Professional Standards Councils, by Wednesday, 14 January 2026.
