



Application Module 5.0 – Members' claims data

A. TO BEGIN THE MODULE

This module sets out the information required from your association to assist the Professional Standards Councils in considering the nature and level of claims made against members of the occupational association in relation to the occupational association's proposed limit of occupational liability.

This information is mandatory under the Professional Standards Legislation for an association to provide when making a first-time application for a Professional Standards Scheme or seeking approval for a Scheme remake.

The module should be read in conjunction with Guidance 5.0.1 *Members claims' data* which is designed to assist you in completing the module.

B. WHAT IS CLAIMS HISTORY IN THE CONTEXT OF A PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS SCHEME?

The nature and level of claims made against members of the occupational association is required to assess the proposed Scheme limit of occupational liability.

Submitting your member's claims history will also allow the Councils to consider the extent of the potential for consumer protection and improved professional standards arising from the Scheme.

C. COMPLETING THE CLAIMS HISTORY

The information required from your association is to be entered in Template 5.0.1 *Members claims data*.
